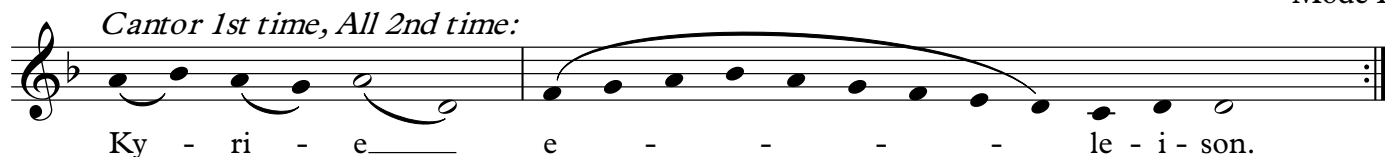

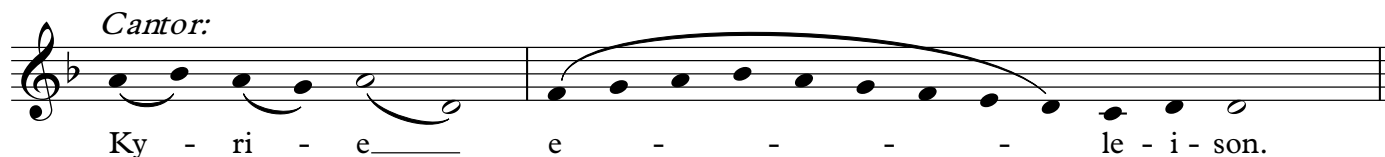

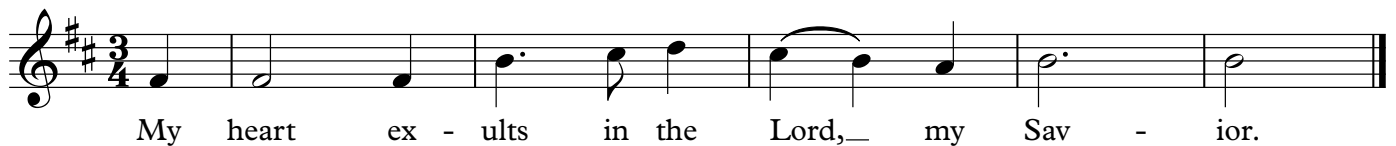
First Reading

Luke 1: 46-56

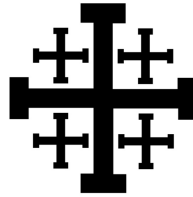

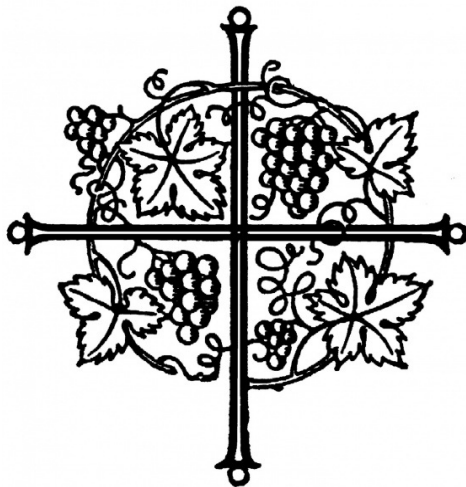
Act of Spiritual Communion

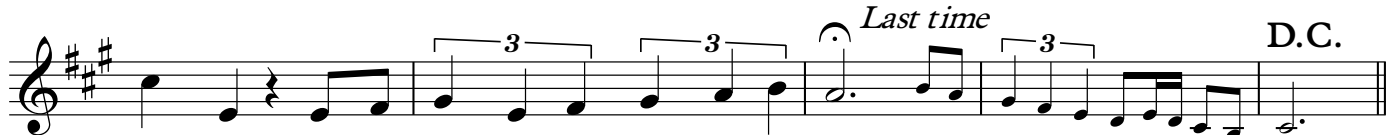


